Criteria for the Fellow class

Candidates will normally be required to satisfy **all** of the following criteria:

- (1) Be at least 35 years of age
- (2) Meet the requirements for the Member class (see overleaf)
- (3) Have held a responsible position in light and lighting or a related field for not less than ten years
- (4) Have made a significant contribution to light and lighting; this may include a contribution to the work of a professional body
- (5) Show evidence of a commitment to continuing professional development.

Candidates will normally be asked to attend an interview.

Fellows of the Society can use the designatory letters FSLL.

Former Founder Members should note that it is necessary for applicants to meet the requirements for the class of Member as stated overleaf.

Detailed criteria for the Member class

Applicants for Fellow must satisfy these requirements of the Member class.

Applicants must meet one of the following sets of education, training and experience criteria, or their equivalent:

- (1) Has successfully completed an approved lighting course which includes the Core and two Applications Modules from the CIBSE lighting syllabus *and* has had at least **five** years' relevant experience in lighting*
- (2) Has passed three BTEC level H (4 or 5) Lighting Units or equivalent examinations *and* has had at least five years' relevant experience in light and lighting
- (3) Is a registered architect who has five years' relevant experience in light and lighting
- (4) Holds the MSc in Light and Lighting of the Bartlett School of Architecture with five years' relevant experience in light and lighting
- (5) Holds a first degree in lighting with five years' relevant experience in light and lighting
- (6) Has Member grade membership of the Institution of Lighting Engineers with five years' relevant experience in light and lighting†
- (7) Has Associate Member grade membership of the Institution of Lighting Engineers with seven years' relevant experience in light and lighting†
- (8) Has achieved a pass in the LIF Advanced Certificate with seven years' relevant experience in light and lighting
- (9) Holds membership at a suitable grade of another professional institution (not including CIBSE) with a minimum of five years' relevant experience in light and lighting (please give details)‡
- (10) Holds the CIBSE Lighting Diploma or held Diploma Membership of the former Illuminating Engineering Society, or is able to meet the current requirements for the Diploma
- (11) Holds an equivalent overseas qualification (to be assessed individually) and has at least five years' relevant experience in light and lighting (please give details)‡
- (12) Experience route: Be at least 28 years of age *and* have had relevant lighting experience over a period of at least 10 years *and* have attained a position demonstrating a level of proven competence in lighting equivalent to that of the relevant academic standards for the specific class applied for *and* successfully complete a professional review
- (13) Experience route: Be at least 28 years of age *and* have had relevant lighting experience over a period of at least 5 years *and* successfully complete a design report covering a lighting project or topic

* A copy of the CIBSE guide lighting syllabus is available on request from the Secretary.

† This period of relevant experience could include the period of approved experience required by the ILE regulations for the Grade concerned.

‡ Period required will depend on the nature of the experience in light and lighting.

NOTE: the period of relevant experience in light and lighting may be aggregated over a period, eg nine years @ 50% plus three years @ 67% plus half a year @ 100% sums to seven years full time.
