

# CIBSE Technical Committee - TM65 Embodied Carbon Updates

The authors Dr Francisco Sierra [University of the West of England, UWE]; Balsam Nehme [Dar Al-Handasah], and Ahmed Hagras [UWE] are developing the TM65 local addendum for the MENA region. The United Arab Emirates is the starting point. The UAE will then be followed by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the rest of the major markets in the MENA region. CIBSE UAE Technical Committee is assisting the authors in providing all the necessary local technical information. The final document will be reviewed and published by CIBSE HQ.

Buildings have a significant impact on global carbon emissions. In the UAE they consume 70% of the energy produced in the country. The entire UAE construction industry is interested in reducing emission levels produced consuming all that energy.

The emissions are of two types. Embodied carbon is the amount of carbon emitted during the extraction of raw materials, the manufacturing of products, their transportation, and their installation in the building. While the operation includes the emissions when using these products.

Currently there is a clear lack of Environmental Product Declarations (EPD) for Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing (MEP) products, without which an accurate Life Cycle Analysis (LCA) of a building cannot be performed. CIBSE TM65 is used to estimate the embodied carbon for building services equipment where an EPD is not available. CIBSE TM65 will help UAE manufacturers to be able to calculate and understand the embodied carbon of their products. That is the starting point to be able to reduce it.

The working group has contextualized the original document by establishing the local coefficients used in the calculation so that the TM65 local addendum for the UAE is accurate and relevant in the UAE context. In this way, the document will accelerate the creation of embodied carbon data points for products such as boilers, chillers, mechanical ventilation, air conditioning systems, etc.

TM65 should be part of the UAE's triumphs towards the goal of ZERO carbon in a year as important for the UAE hosting the United Nations Climate Change Conference COP28. TM65 is an action project to raise awareness in the UAE about the need to start reducing embodied carbon and converting construction services into a more sustainable industry.
