John was an ILEVE Member from the very early days of ILEVE and whilst not a member of the Steering Committee, although he considered this some years ago, he was always very supportive of ILEVE.

He was a regular speaker at the ILEVE BOHS LEV conferences, always available to members for support using his wealth of experience and knowledge and provided critical input to TR40, A Guide to Good Practice in LEV, which is a BESA/ILEVE document being referred to by many in the industry.
