# Becoming a Fellow (FSLL) of the Society of Light and Lighting

## **Application routes for FSLL**

Candidates will normally be required to satisfy all the following criteria:

- Must have met requirements for the Member (MSLL) grade (listed below)
- Have held a responsible position in light and lighting or a related field for not less than ten years.
- Have made a significant contribution to light and lighting; this may include a contribution to the work of a professional body.
- Show evidence of a commitment to continuing professional development.

#### Requirements for Member (MSLL)

# • Education + 5 year period of relevant experience in light and lighting

- Hold a 1st degree, Master's degree or doctorate degree in lighting (courses to be assessed individually for

doctorate and overseas qualifications – please provide evidence)

- Has achieved a pass in 3 LIA Advanced Certificate modules
- Has achieved a pass in the LET Diploma
- Has passed 3 BTEC National Certificate Lighting units (level H 4 or 5) or equivalent examinations
  - Membership of other organizations + 5 year period of relevant experience in light and lighting
- Has obtained CEng
- Is a registered architect
  - Critical Report + 5 year period of relevant experience in light and lighting
- Has relevant lighting experience over a period of at least 5 years and successfully complete a critical design report -covering a lighting project or topic (criteria at <a href="https://www.sll.org.uk">www.sll.org.uk</a>)
  - Education + 7 year period of relevant experience in light and lighting
- Has undertaken an approved course based on the CIBSE Core syllabus in lighting
- Has achieved a pass in 2 LIA Advanced Certificate modules
  - Professional Review + 10 year period of relevant experience in light and lighting
- Has relevant experience in light and lighting over a period of 10 years *and* has attained a position demonstrating a level or proven competence in light and lighting *and* has successfully completed a professional review statement (criteria at <a href="www.sll.org.uk">www.sll.org.uk</a>)

The candidate should also show evidence of a commitment to continuing professional development.

## **Application Checklist**

I have fully described each period of employment and experience during my career.	
Against each period of employment, or separate role during that employment, I have indicated the percentage of time I spent working directly on lighting	
I have met the criteria for MSLL, as outlined above	
I have provided a clear outline of my contributions to the lighting industry, considering any voluntary work for professional bodies and/or membership organisations; speaking at live events; developing and/delivering lighting training; contributing to lighting research; mentoring others and supporting them to develop a career within the lighting industry; and actively participating in raising awareness around the importance of a quality lit environment.	
I have supplied certificates for qualifications which may be relevant to my application	
I have provided evidence of a commitment to maintaining my continued professional development	
If applying based on experience, I have provided a professional review/critical report, illustrating my knowledge and experience in relation to light and lighting	
The application has been signed off by my proposer	
I have signed the declaration, confirming that the information provided is accurate
