#### Q: How many years of experience is required to join the SFE?

A: Associate membership is for people with 3+ years of relevant experience, depending on qualifications and Member is for those with 5+ years of relevant experience, depending on qualifications.

Your application will take between 6-8 weeks to be assessed but please note it can take longer if additional information is required.

#### Q: Who can sponsor my application?

A: If you are applying for the class of Associate, Member or Fellow, please have this section completed by a proposer who knows your background and recent work and can validate your experience listed above. Such a proposer should preferably be a Member of the Society or a corporate member of a relevant professional institution and be willing to provide supplementary evidence to the Membership Panel if required
